About the choir

The Huddersfield Singers is a chamber choir with 30–40 members. Formerly known as the Huddersfield Glee & Madrigal Society, the choir was established in 1875 and is the second-oldest secular singing group in the area after the Huddersfield Choral Society. It typically performs programmes of serious music with enterprising repertoire.

Following a period of nearly 25 years of stability, the choir now finds itself in need of a new conductor to lead the group, plan its repertoire and, ideally, expand its horizons and prospects.

The choir hopes to appoint a new conductor for the beginning of its 2014–2015 season, to start work in **September 2014**.

Commitment and expectations

The choir rehearses weekly on **Monday evenings from 7:30 to 9:30pm** in the Methodist Mission, Lord Street, Huddersfield.

The season comprises three regular concerts: **Winter** (November or December), **Spring** (March or April) and **Summer** (June or July).

The Conductor's primary responsibilities will be to:

- Plan the season's repertoire;
- Take the weekly rehearsals;
- Conduct the seasonal concerts.

Assistance with musical planning is available if required, but there is a real opportunity here for a new conductor to make a mark with the group in terms of the music it presents.
